GCA SUPPORTS STRATEGIES TO ADDRESS CLIMATE CHANGE

The Garden Club of America recognizes the serious reality of climate change that is influenced by global warming. GCA is committed to preserving worldwide biodiversity. Global warming compels GCA to educate its members and the public about the causes and consequences as well as ways in which to respond. Plants form the basis for human life as the producers of oxygen and as the basis of the food chain; without plants, life on earth is not possible.

Therefore, The Garden Club of America supports:

- Peer reviewed independent scientific study of climate change phenomena.
- Public education and open discourse on the subject of climate change.
- Federal, state and local legislation as well as individual initiatives to control greenhouse gases.
- Federal, state and local initiatives to slow global warming.
- Initiatives to protect oceans, which produce over two thirds of the world's supply of oxygen and over half its biological production.
- Initiatives to support sustainable forests, which help ensure clean air and watershed protection.
- Adaptation strategies for human, animal and plant communities.
- Exploration of the positive economic opportunities that will become available through research and development of new technologies.
